There were 13 applications reviewed in the first quarter of 2023.

- 7 Individual or Family applications all approved for a total of \$16,500
- 6 Organization or Agency applications all except one approved for a total of \$24,500

Approved Applications

The Food Bank of Central and Northeast Missouri was awarded \$7,500 to assist with their Buddy Pack Program that provides meals for low-income students attending schools in Cole, Maries, Miller and Osage Counties.






More Than Enough Ministries was awarded \$1,000 to assist with improvements to Camp Hope for Kids, a camp for children in foster care.

Two families and one individual received a total of \$11,000 to assist with replacing items in their homes due to house fires.

Touch of Hope was awarded \$1,500 to assist with providing care bags for homeless individuals or individuals fleeing from domestic violence.







Maries County 4-H & FFA Livestock Committee was awarded \$10,000 to assist with installing a handicap accessible restroom in their expo barn.

Three individuals received a total of \$3,000 to assist with dental expenses.

OATS Transit was awarded \$4,500 to assist with transportation expenses for disabled and elderly citizens.
