Foundation Update January – March 2018

There were 23 applications reviewed in the first quarter of 2018.

- 19 Individual or Family applications 18 approved for a total of \$24,058.43
- 4 Organization or Agency applications 3 approved for a total of \$15,000.00

Approved Applications

The Hermann Community Food Pantry was awarded \$5,000 to assist with providing meals to students from low-income families.

Two individuals and one couple were awarded a total of **\$3,760.43** to assist with medical expenses.





Owensville Senior Center was awarded \$5,000 for their homebound meals program.

Six individuals received a total of \$5,298 to assist with dental expenses.

Four individuals were awarded a total of \$10,000 to assist with medical expenses as a result of treatment for cancer.

Five families received a total of \$5,000 in emergency assistance to help with food and clothing after their homes were destroyed by fire.

The Senior Nutrition Council of Jefferson City/Cole County was awarded \$5,000 to assist with meals for homebound individuals.
