Foundation Update April – June 2019

There were **29** applications reviewed in the **second quarter** of **2019**.

26 – Individual or Family applications – all except two approved for a total of \$41,180

3 – Organization or Agency applications – all approved for a total of \$10,500

Approved Applications

The Cooper Foundation of MO received \$2,000 to assist with Boston's Backpacks, a program that provides school supplies to children in need.

Six individuals received a total of \$5,957 to assist with dental expenses.





The Owensville Senior Center was awarded \$3,500 to assist with providing meals for their homebound meal program.

Two individuals received a total of \$4,223 to assist with medical and dental expenses.

Five individuals and one family received a total of \$17,500 to assist with medical expenses.

One family received **\$5,000** to assist with expenses resulting from a house fire.

Nine families received a total of \$8,500 to assist with expenses after their homes were damaged by a tornado.

Helping Hands Outreach Center of Gasconade County received \$5,000 to assist with installing ADA compliant restrooms in their new facility.
