There were **14** applications reviewed in the **first quarter** of **2022**.

9 – Individual or Family applications – all approved for a total of **\$11,882.57**

5 – Organization or Agency applications – all approved for a total of **\$14,900**

Approved Applications

Touch of Hope was awarded **\$1,000** to assist with providing care bags for homeless individuals or individuals fleeing from domestic violence.

Four individuals received a total of **\$3,852.25** to assist with dental expenses.



The Food Bank for Central and Northeast Missouri was awarded **\$5,000** to assist with their Buddy Pack Program that provides meals for low-income students attending schools in Cole, Maries, Miller and Osage Counties.

One individual received **\$1,500** to assist with purchasing hearing aids.

Senior Nutrition Council of JC/Cole County was awarded **\$5,200** to assist with replacing a built-in food warmer at the Clarke Nutrition Center.

One individual fighting cancer received a total of **\$2,500** to assist with medical and dental expenses.



City of Owensville Parks and Recreation Department was awarded **\$2,700** to assist with installing an accessible sidewalk and parking spaces to Buschmann Park.

Three individuals received a total of **\$4,030.32** to assist with medical expenses.



Historical Society of Maries County received **\$1,000** to assist with preservation materials.
