There were 14 applications reviewed in the first quarter of 2022.

- 9 Individual or Family applications all approved for a total of \$11,882.57
- 5 Organization or Agency applications all approved for a total of \$14,900

## **Approved Applications**

Touch of Hope was awarded \$1,000 to assist with providing care bags for homeless individuals or individuals fleeing from domestic violence.

Four individuals received a total of \$3,852.25 to assist with dental expenses.


